You are invited to contribute your **original**, **preferably**, **unpublished research paper** to the 27th issue of the *Jnana-Pravaha Research Journal: 2023-2024* scheduled to be released on 1st of August 2024.

This volume is contemplated to be a Special Issue on FACETS OF INDIAN TEXTILE.

Some of the suggested areas are: any phase of Indian textile history, Indian textile vis-avis epigraphical evidences, Indian textile vis-a-vis archaeological findings, Indian textile vis-a-vis literary references, Indian textile vis-a-vis any particular collection, etc.

A particular style sheet is being followed for Jnana-Pravaha Research Journal. The details are as follows:

- (1) The contributors are requested to avoid the use of diacritical marks in their text.
- (2) The non-English words/technical terms should be in *italics*.
- (3) Approximate word limit for the article: 2000 words (including the endnotes).
- (4) Number of illustrations: Preferably 10 good quality, high resolution images, 300 dpi and above.
- (5) Standard format for the captions of the illustrations: Main Subject, Provenance/Style/Date, Material/Dimensions, Current Location, Photo Courtesy.

 - (iii) <u>For edited book article</u>: Author Surname, Name, Year, "Title of article", in *Name of book* (Editor Name), Place, Pages.
 - Sample: McInerney, Terence, 2011, "Mir Kalan Khan", in *Masters of Indian Painting: 1650-1900, Vol.II* (Eds. M.C. Beach et.al.), Zurich, pp.607-622.
 - (iv) <u>For Journal/Periodical</u>: Author Surname, Name, Year, "Title of article", in *Name of Journal*, Volume, Ed. name, Place, Pages.
 - Sample: Cohen, Steven, 1986, "Textiles", in *Islamic Heritage of the Deccan*, ed. George Michell, Bombay, pp.118-128.

Besides authoring more than 80 research papers and 25 books, she is particularly credited for publishing books on ancient Varanasi, the area of her numerous field researches.
